About Peer Networks

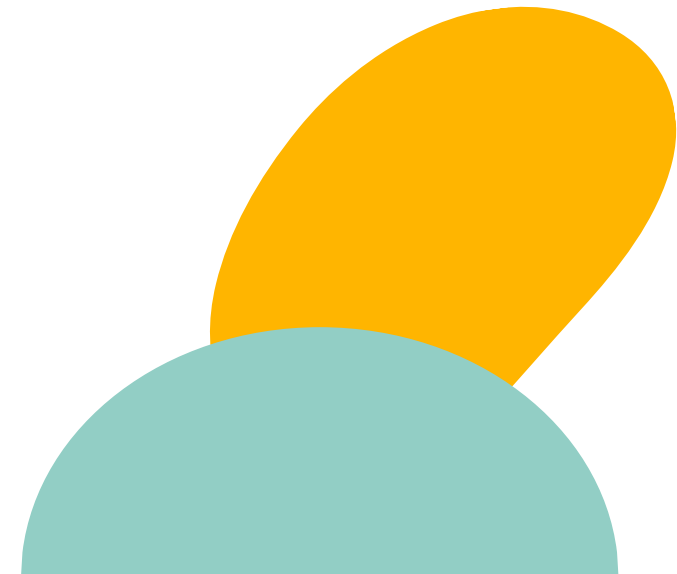
Peer Networks is a national peer-to-peer networking programme for SME leaders that want to grow and develop their organisation for future success.
